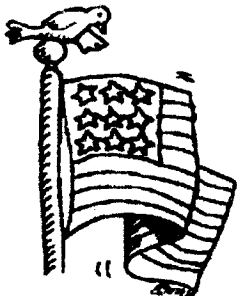
Report Cards go home TODAY. Please return the Report Card envelope with 2 \$.37 stamps. In the event of a price change you will be notified.

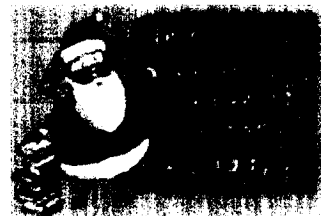
Jaguar Readers Club
