**BIKE SAFETY:** If your child/children ride their bike to school, please make sure their route is safe, and they know where and how to cross a busy street. Thanks!

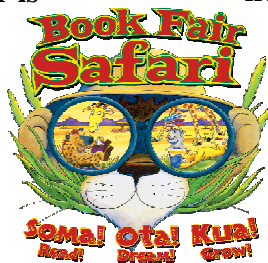
