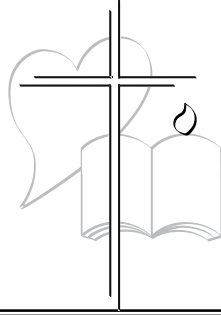

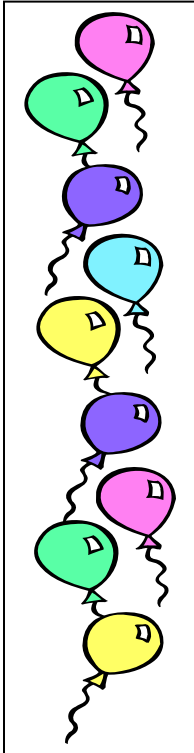

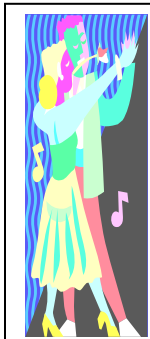
**Friday** – Pal activity
