The St. Greg's Athletic Club is happy to announce that electronic registration will start this month for 2010 CYO Fall Sports. The electronic registration form can be accessed through the Athletics page on the St. Greg's website. (www.stgregoryonline.org) Electronic Registration is a simple process and can be completed using any desktop or laptop with internet access.

Students in the 4th through 8th grade may participate in the one of the following CYO Fall Sports offered through St. Gregory the Great: boys football, girls volleyball, and boys and girls cross country. Students must be registered no later than Friday June 4th. It is important to remember that your child is not registered for a sport until the following is received: participation fee, uniform deposit, Emergency Authorization Form, and Preparticipation Medical Form. Please click on the 5 Step Process of the Fall Eligibility section of the Sports Registration page to download required forms.

The St. Gregory the Great CYO Football Program is getting organized for the fall 2010 season and we are looking to improve the team and get more players involved.

- Signups: Football (Fall Sports) Registration forms are available on the St. Gregory the Great School website at <http://www.stgregoryathletics.org/SGMenuPage.asp> starting 5/10/10. Please follow the 5-step process outlined.
- Cost is \$100/player. A separate deposit check is required for equipment. All uniforms and equipment except for shoes are provided by the program.
- Fitness Evaluations: Thursday OR Friday May 27th & May 28th from 4:00 to 5:00PM at St. Greg's (mandatory for incoming 7th and 8th grade players).
- Mini-Camp: Monday-Friday; July 26th – 30th from 5:00 to 7:15PM each day at St. Greg's. Open to all interested athletes grades 4 through 8.
- The program is open to all CYO eligible athletes in grades 4 - 8.
