

March 13, 2003 Minutes

The March 13, 2003 Advisory Board Meeting commenced at 7:00 p.m. Present at the meeting were Mark Geyman, Barb Mastroianni, Chuck Brown, Lucy Iemmelo, Greg Stuart, Tom Dowd, and John Amantea. Absent were Bob Hostoffer, and Fr. Peyton.

The meeting began with a prayer. The minutes of the February 13, 2003 meeting were reviewed and approved. The Principal report followed. The Principal reported that 55 kindergarten applications were received and the school is anticipating two kindergartens and two first grades. The projected enrollment is 581.

Maureen Becker was hired as the Science Lab Teacher. She is anticipated to work twenty hours per week. Financial reports for the lab will be furnished to the advisory board.

Tom Dowd and John Amantea have materials for the upcoming elections for the Board and will circulate information in the newsletter.

The endowment board is meeting on 3/25/03, and all are welcome

The technology committee reported that wireless systems are being assessed. The student handbook review is underway and Lucy Iemmolo anticipates the handbook should be ready for review in August. The extracurricular policy was informally discussed with the athletic director. The board agreed to postpone activity until a parish council was formed.

The marketing committee is scheduling a meeting to discuss the brochure. The communications committee suggested the minutes be placed on the website. The meeting was adjourned at 8:02.
